### **REMINDERS**



- Please inform your licensing worker of any upcoming changes in your home. including who resides there, phone number or email changes, or any health changes. If you have a family member or friend who will be residing in your home or spending time around our foster youth for two weeks or more, CTS health NEEDS to be informed so we can preform a background check to ensure the safety of our FY.
- Re-license packets will continue to be sent out 6 months prior to your renewal date. Please work on your packet once you receive it as they need to be submitted to the state 2 months prior to your renewal date. Failure to turn them in on time could result in a unexpected removal of FY.
- Please continue to keep up with your monthly fire drills and disaster drills!!! If you need fire drill forms, reach out to your licensing specialist or care coordinator.



## **MORE REMINDERS**



- Reminder that if doing respite for any level kiddo, the respite parent must do a note for that child NOT the regular FP who's placement it is. If the foster child is not added to you for respite in Ontarget, please reach out to your CC for assistance.
- Don't forget to keep up with your DAILY notes in OnTarget. You can do these from your phone and/or computer by going to www.ontargetclinical.com. If you want to do them on your phone, go to the site listed above, click on the full site tab in the lower right hand corner. This will take you directly to the login page. If you have any questions or concerns at all, please reach out to any of your CTS staff.
- Please be respectful of moving or canceling appointments with your licensing specialist. Please cancel/reschedule with enough time & please write down the date/time of scheduled appt. in your phone or calendar.
